Clean your refrigerator coils. The coils hold liquid that cools the air inside the refrigerator. It takes a lot more energy to cool the refrigerator when the coils are covered with lint and dust. Refrigerator coils should be cleaned at least twice a year. Pull the refrigerator out from the wall. Vacuum out all the dust, and then wipe down the coils with a damp cloth. In just a few minutes, you can cut your refrigerator's energy use by up to 6 percent!

Note: if we decide to cancel the Sunday 8:00 and 9:30 am worship services, Christian Formation Classes will also be cancelled for that morning. Every attempt will be made to hold the 11:00 am service, but it may be cancelled if conditions are too severe or if parking lots and sidewalks cannot be cleared in time.
