### CREATION CARE TIP

 It takes a lot of energy to preheat the oven; the longer the oven is on but not used, the more energy it wastes. Your oven only needs a few minutes to reach the desired temperature, so heat it when you're ready to make dinner, not 30 minutes before. If you bake twice a week, you can save almost 50 pounds of carbon per year by not preheating the oven earlier than necessary.
