SHARING GOD'S WORD



Christian Formation is *Sharing God's Word* by providing Bible studies, women's groups, an elementary youth group, fellowship, and Sunday morning Christian Formation groups. Here are opportunities for all ages, birth to adults:

Newborns to 2-year-old children meet in the nursery. The Nursery Coordinator will bring children into worship for Children's Time with the pastors and then return them to the nursery where they will listen to simple Bible stories and songs.

Children 3 years to 3rd grade begin in the Sanctuary. After Children's Time with the pastors, children go to their classes listed below:

- Preschool children go upstairs to the Teddi Nelson Education Wing.
- Children K-3rd Grade will go to the MAC (Muhlenberg Activities Center – behind the church) on the 1st and 3rd Sundays. On the 2nd and 4th Sundays, they will go to the Nielsen Room for Children's Church and then return to their parents in worship.

Children in grades 4-5 start at 9:30 upstairs in the MAC.

All children should be picked up from their classes immediately following the end of the 9:30 service.

Children's Church at 11:00 on the 1st & 3rd Sundays is for children 3-7 years old (*held downstairs in the Nielsen Room*). Children will join their families in the Sanctuary during the Offering Song.

RESPONSE TO SEXUAL ABUSE IN PENNSYLVANIA DIOCESES

As a congregation, we share the shock and sadness felt by many at the news of rampant clergy abuse of children in six Roman Catholic dioceses in Pennsylvania, subsequent institutional indifference to the harm done to child victims, and efforts to cover up their abuse. Specifically, we hold in prayer the victims and survivors as they struggle for healing and hope in their lives. We pray, too, for predators to be brought to justice, and for institutional reforms that will protect the most vulnerable in communities of faith, especially children and youth.

We also remind **members and friends of Muhlenberg that we are a flagship member of the Safe Church program**, by which we commit proactively to policies and procedures designed to prevent the
