### CREATION CARE TIP



Buy in bulk and use “refills.” When practical, buy the economy size of a product rather than single use. Not only will you reduce packaging, you’ll save money. You pay nearly twice the price for the same weight when you buy the individually wrapped product. Fabric softener, laundry detergent, cleanser, hand soap, dish soap, shampoo, and even pet food are good examples of products you can buy in bulk sizes to refill a smaller container at home.
