current recipient, Mycah McNett, has just graduated from United Lutheran Seminary and accepted a call to St. Luke Lutheran Church in Devon, PA.

The Mission Endowment Fund is the other account. Proceeds from the interest gained from this investment fund are used to assist programs in alignment with Muhlenberg's mission outside the church's budgeted items. The church Council selects the recipients, which have included the Harrisonburg Rockingham Free Clinic, First Step (a local domestic violence shelter) and our Wellstream program and its equipment. Suggestions for future designees are always welcomed.
