Our Congregation Council spent the bulk of our August 21 meeting continuing our work with the Constitution Task Force (Cathy Copeland, Brad Moyers, Pastor Lauren Eanes) at making proposed revisions to our out-of-date Constitution. We intend to have revised documents available for review and feedback in October for our first of two congregational meeting votes Sunday, November 19 between services.

ABOUT OUR WORSHIP

For our Food and Faith series Sundays, August 20 — September 3, we will reuse our booklets. Hymn numbers worship and Scripture readings for each Sunday are provided in the booklet. Participants in worship are listed in *The Chimes* (see page 5 this week).

CARING FOR CREATION AT COMMUNION

During our Creation Care series (August 20-September 3), we'll be sharing bread from Mill Song Bakery here in Harrisonburg. All of Mill Song's breads are naturally leavened; they do not use any commercial yeast in their breads. They also do not buy any flour, but stone mill their own flour on-site weekly, and source their grains from the Chesapeake Bay watershed.

The small cups in which we receive our wine are Biodegradable Products Institute (BPI®) Certified Compostable, and are made from a bio-resin made from corn. ~continued on page 2~

CARING FOR CREATION AT COMMUNION (CONT'D) Each week these cups are transported to a commercial composting facility, where they'll compost within 100 days.

We'd like to continue to make our communion meal ecofriendly and connected to the earth.
