#### **COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS**

At its September 18 meeting, our Congregation Council ...

- Had initial discussions regarding the 2024 proposed congregational budget, having utilized information gleaned from the Treasurer and President's meetings with ministry chairs and staff members. The budget will be finalized at the October council meeting and will then be presented to the congregation to be discussed and voted on at the November 19 Congregational Meeting. The meeting will be held at 9:45 and requires a minimum of 50 active voting members, so mark your calendars now!
- Approved the installation of **4 EV Charging Stations** along the side of the MAC to serve as the only downtown electric vehicle fueling station (other than the 2 at HEC) for a reasonable rate to bring additional income to the church and care for the environment.
- Approved well deserved **Summer 2025 Sabbatical for Pastor Lauren**.
- Received a request for a MLC sponsored Family Cub Scout Pack from Matt Philippi as there is currently no cub scout pack in

Harrisonburg city. (Answers to essential questions are being sought out prior to moving forward).

 Discussed continued updating of the MLC Constitution in the next 2 weeks to share with the congregation for questions and input in October, and vote at the November and January Congregational Meetings.

This spring, over 90 people participated in our Lenten *Why Groups*. These four-week small group experiences focused on gathering to get to know one another more deeply and explore questions of faith together. We heard overwhelmingly positive feedback about the experience, and so we're bringing them back this October!

October *Why Groups* will focus less on the question "Why?" and more on the question "Who?" Who are we? We'll dig into stories about Moses, Ruth, and David to learn more about how God's people discover who they are, and whose they are. Some groups will be structured to focus on a particular season of a person's life, such as young adults, parents of teens, retirees, etc., while others will invite any and all people to join around an activity such as hiking or trying new restaurants in town. #### **CREATION CARE**

are several wavs to maximize the efficiency to boil water:



- Use lukewarm rather than cold water to start.
- Boil only the amount of water needed.
- Use the heating element on the range that fits your kettle/pot.

#### **CONFIRMATION CORNER**

Confirmation isn't just for middle schoolers! All the baptized who have been confirmed are called to grow in faith and affirm God's promises in their life. You can support the hard work of our middle school students by reflecting on these Confirmation Corner thoughts each week. Here's a confirmation prompt for this week:

Luther maintained that there is no spiritual divide between priests and laity; there is simply "one estate" to which all baptized believers belong. Because justification by faith puts all baptized believers on equal footing, there are no tiers of spirituality or hierarchy in accessing God. In Luther's mind, this made parents the "Bishops of their homes," pastoring to their priestly children! For parents, how do you feel about this role of Bishop? For all, what does it mean to you to be a part of this holy calling?
