COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

At our October 16 meeting, the Congregation Council:

- Approved a revised constitution to be brought to the congregation for the first of 2 votes at our 9:45 am Congregational Meeting on November 19 and again January 28.
- 2. Approved the 2024 Ministry Spending Plan to be brought to the congregation for vote at the November 19 meeting.
- 3. Amended the personnel manual to reflect Synod guidelines for parental leave from 8 weeks to 12 weeks.

We look forward to seeing all of our voting members at the Congregational Meeting Sunday, November 19 at 9:45 (a quorum of 50 voting members is required for a congregational vote).

MUSIC MINISTRY UPDATE

We are delighted to announce Linlin Uta will be serving as our Interim Music Minister! Linlin has served as our Music Ministry Accompanist for four years, and has shared her incredible musical skills and sunny demeanor with us throughout that time. She is currently pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Piano Performance, Pedagogy and Literature at James Madison University. She serves as adjunct faculty at James Madison University as well as the chair of music theory for Harrisonburg Music Teachers Association.

Linlin will serve part-time in this role, averaging 20 hours a week. Her main responsibilities will be leading our two adult choirs and the Youth Ensemble, as well as overseeing special music and recitals. We are grateful that Linlin has accepted our invitation to serve in this role and share her God-given gifts with us. She can be reached by calling the

During our interim time, we'll also have weekly organists stepping in to lead our congregation in song. A big thanks to **Judith Ofcarcik**, who will lead several times a month. We'll have a few more familiar faces on the organ bench over the coming months ... stay tuned!

We are also incredibly grateful for the ongoing service of Gloria Dei Ringers Director Kath Wissinger and Children's Choir Director Rachel Peters. Both are stepping up to "fill the gaps" and ensure a consistent, quality music program during our interim time.

And all this is done out of pure, fatherly, and divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness of mine at all! For all of this I owe it to God to thank and praise, serve and obey him. This is most certainly true."
